Final Reminder for Registration – if you have already registered, you can disregard the following:

- Registration was open from May 1st, 2025 to May 31st, 2025
- After May 31st, 2025, transportation applications will not be processed until August 2025.
- Late registrants who do not receive confirmation prior to the first day of classes may not be permitted a ride.
- CHANGE FORMS will be required for changing schools (i.e. Grade 7 to 8) and all address, medical or contact information changes
